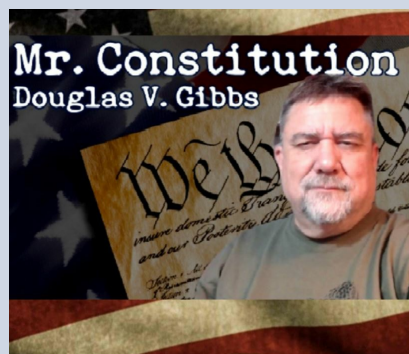
January Luncheon
