Nick Meade - Executive Director of Fix California

Nick's list of community involvement is vast. He is the Vice Chairman of the Log Cabin Republicans of California and President of the Coachella Valley chapter. He is the Chairman of the Political Affairs Committee for The Lincoln Club of Coachella Valley and is joining the National Young Republicans as their Executive Director next month.

Recently, Nick stepped down as the Vice Chair of Communications for the Republican Party of Riverside County to focus his efforts on Fix California by increasing conservative voter registration throughout the state. He served on the Board of Directors for the City of Palm Desert Chamber of Commerce as the Chair of the Legislative Action Committee.

Nick is a former high school CIF Championship wrestling coach working on his debut book, "Undocrination," a conservative student guide to beating the leftist's agenda in the college classroom.
