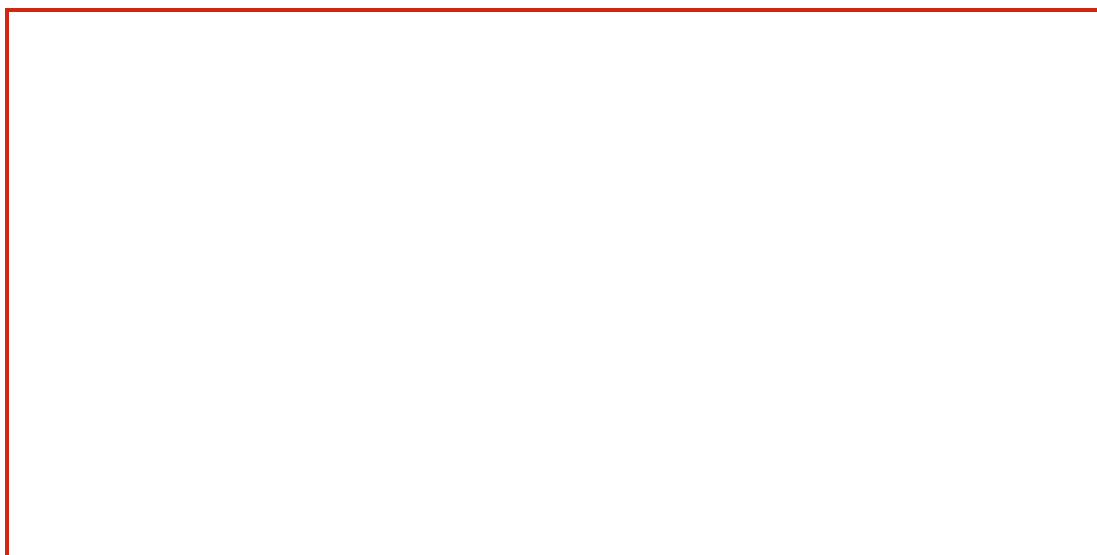
Volunteer Action
